Applying for jobs through Seek automatically loads your CV onto their database, called 'Seek Talent Search', a great tool for recruiters and employers to use when looking for candidates. However, even if you don't apply for jobs directly, we encourage you to create a profile and upload your CV so that it can land on this database. Complete the registration process, and from there you can create a profile and upload your CV.

LinkedIn



LinkedIn is another great place for recruiters and employers to advertise roles. You should ensure that your LinkedIn profile is smart, up-to-date with an appropriate and professional photo. But you can also add your CV. To do this, on the top part of your profile click "Add profile section" followed by "Featured", then "Media." You can then download your CV from your computer.

Indeed is one of the largest CV databases in the US, and quickly becoming a key competitor to Seek here in Australia. It is another great place to look and apply for roles, and in doing so will automatically load your CV on the database for recruiters and employers to find. On the homepage, simply click "upload your resume."

Jora is another large job advertisement platform, and one not to be missed when it comes to getting your CV out there. On the homepage, find the "upload your CV" button in the top right hand corner.
